FIELD PREPARATION:

Host regions are responsible for field preparation prior to game dates. Both teams of the last game of the day shall assist with the break down of fields, unless otherwise instructed by host region. Minimum field size: 110x55 yds.

CANCELLATIONS:

Host Regional Commissioners or designated regional field coordinator shall be responsible for contacting U-16/19 Boys AGC, Kent Goya, by 7:00 a.m. on Saturdays, who will contact all coaches and regional commissioners by 7:30 a.m. ONLY in the event of field closure or unplayable conditions. A minimum of seven (7) players per team is required to begin or continue a game. Coaches are responsible for contacting AGC in the event of forfeits.

PLAYER NOTES:

Players may not participate on more than one spring season team. To be eligible to play, players (including Guest Players), absent special circumstances, must be registered and have actively participated in at least half of the scheduled games during the AYSO primary program held by their respective region, area or section that started after August 1, 2009 and ended before March 13, 2010. For purposes of this determination, refer to the latest revision of the Section 7 Rules and Regulations. Each regional commissioner is responsible for ensuring that all Section 7 rules and regulations and the spirit of their intent is honored. The Section Spring Director, respective Area Director and Section Director collectively reserve the right to determine and administer any discipline that they deem appropriate should they find that the participation of any team or player violates the rules or their intent. Disciplinary sanctions can include, but are not limited to, removing or rejecting the offending team or player from participation in all or any part of the spring season.

COACHING NOTES:

Coaches shall be responsible for the conduct of his or her players and spectators before, during and after all games. Coaches shall be responsible for completing the fill-in portion of game cards, including Region name, coaches name(s), date, time, field location and home or visitor status, prior to submittal to game officials. Home team shall have choice of side and will be responsible for providing officiating team with water during halftime and for providing the game ball.

OFFICIATING NOTES:

Teams are responsible for providing qualified referee teams for each assignment. Referee teams shall consist of a center referee and two assistant referees. Referees should be dressed appropriately, alike and in contrasting colors to the participating teams. In the event teams are not able to provide referees for their assignments, alternate arrangements must be made between coaches. The referee shall be responsible for recording player substitutions by quarters and completing the reverse portion of the game card including Sportsmanship, halftime and final game scores. Referee of last game of day shall be responsible for mailing completed game cards as soon as possible to AGC at 45-454 Puahuula Place, Kaneohe, 96744.

CAUTIONS and EJECTIONS:

Refer to the latest revision of the Section 7 Winter/Spring Season Rules and Regulations and the Section 7 Rules and Regulations. In the event of conflict, the Section 7 Rules and Regulations shall take precedence.

POST GAME:
