Instructions: Hold your CTRL key down and left click on the respective blue-colored text (beginning with “http://”) associated with the field you need directions to.

Note: All of the directions shown in the maps assume you are coming over the H-3 freeway from Halawa. Names in quotations are the commonly known names of the fields. Names after the comma are the formal names. Please also note that the restrooms at Kaneohe Elem. and/or Ben Parker Elem. may not be available each Saturday. The next nearest restroom facility near Kaneohe Elem. is at the McDonald’s on the corner of Kaneohe Bay Drive and Aumoku St. At Ben Parker, it is at the Kaneohe Police Station. The rest of the fields have city or state-maintained restroom facilities.

Go just past the Kaneohe Police Station on Waikalua Road and, at what looks like the exit from the police station, turn right and continue down the hill. The Kaneohe Public Library will be on your right and Civic Field will be on your left.

After turning left (mauka) onto Keaahala Road from Kahekili Hwy, the parking lot for both fields will be on your right. Both fields are on the right side of Keaahala Road. Upper Hokulele is located behind (on the Kahaluu side of) the tennis courts. Lower Hokulele is located adjacent to Kahekili Highway.

There are two additional ways (other than what’s shown on the map) to get to parking. One is to continue up Mokulele Drive (instead of left at Iole Street), turn left onto Mikihilina Street and then turn left into Hikiwale Place (cul-de-sac). The other is to

continue on Kaneohe Bay Drive toward Kailua to Keana Road, turn right, and the park will be on your right. Parking is available on either Keana Road or in the cul-de-sac of Hikiwale Place.
